

BEFORE JULY 1

- Know your group assignment and group mates
- Familiarize yourself with the venue (gym, auditorium, canteen, CR's, etc.) and the schedule
- Go over the Facilitators' Guide
- PRAY for the success of the celebration
- Prepare the place



REGISTRATION LOGISTICS

- Gather in one place with the other facilitators of your group. Wait for further instructions from your Group Coordinator.
- Get your list of members
- Check the place for the Mass, Group Sharing, Adoration
- Be on your assigned place to welcome your members



MASS

Be familiar with the flow of the mass



SNACKS & MEALS

- Be attentive to the instructions about the distribution of food
- Keep the area neat and clean.



ADORATION

- Remind your group members about your schedule for adoration.
- During the adoration, help maintain silence and an atmosphere of prayer
- PRAY!



GROUP DYNAMICS

- Be familiar with the flow of the sharing
- Encourage your members to participate.
 Establish a friendly rapport with them.
- Make sure that each member has the opportunity to share.
- Keep the time



- Duration: 1 -1 ½ hour
- Facilitator Member ratio: 1: 20 (max)
- Materials:
- Booklet of the participants
- E-card (Eucharistic Year Card) according to your group color
- Scissors, coloring pens or crayons, glue, stapler, scotch tape, pencils
- Instrumental music



Definition

Sub-group: 1 Facilitator = 20 participants

Group: 1 Head Facilitator = 200/250 participants

Plenary: 1000+ facilitators & participants



One of the Facilitators will give a short Catechesis of the significance of July 1st for the whole group, and orient the members of what had happened during the Eucharistic Year.

Summary

Sharing

• Share your symbol.



After the sharing

- Gather together your symbols, and place them in the container provided for the group. These will be offered during the Vespers/Concluding Prayers as your offering to Jesus.
- As a group, prepare a prayer to accompany your offering. Such prayer must also be related to or speak something on the corresponding name of your group – (Eucharistic Act of Jesus)
- Assign a person who will read this prayer; and while the prayer is read, all members of the group will stand.
